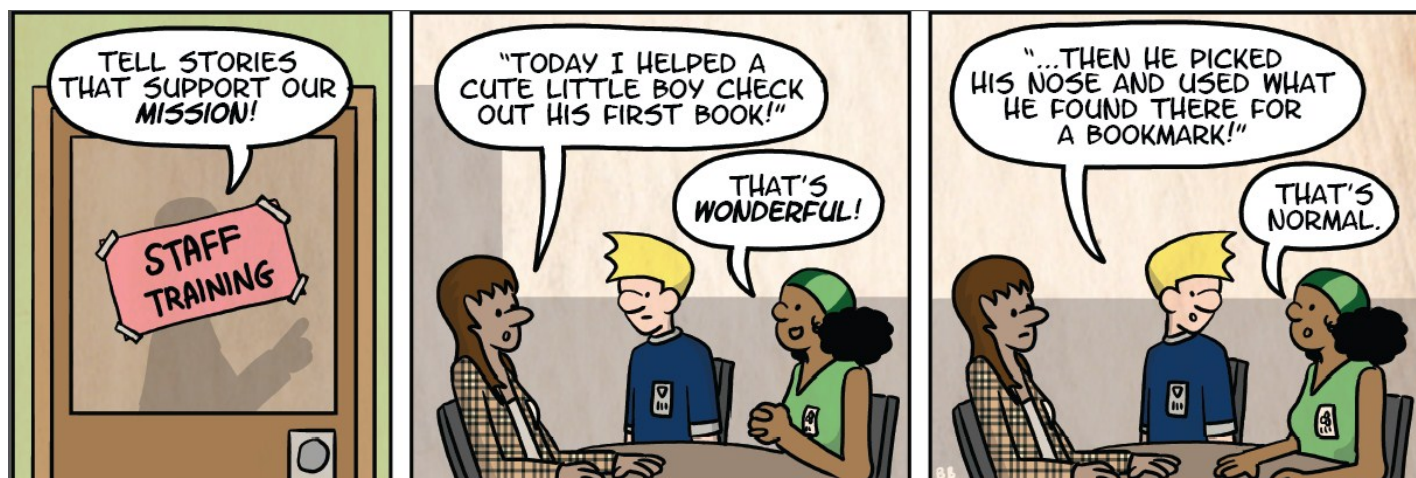

Pre-AGM Meeting begins 1:30-2:30 in the Thompson Room, located in the Clubhouse.


